*SCAPE TO SUPPORT YOUTHS FROM STARTUP WEEKEND THROUGH GREEN- LANE TO HUBQUARTERS FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME

- In line with *SCAPE's vision and mission to nurture youths and to provide them with the right platforms and opportunities to develop, grow and achieve their entrepreneurial dreams, *SCAPE is supporting Startup Weekend (SWSG) that has happened over the weekend from 28th to 30th September.
- As one of the largest open innovation hackathons in Singapore, participants in Startup Weekend were encouraged to address some of the region's biggest challenges and conceive public good solutions that will have the greatest impact on youths, seniors, community, health and environment.
- Over 54 hours between 28th to 30th September, 280 participants has pitched their ideas, formed teams, developed their prototypes and get guidance from tech industry mentors.
- The 5 winning teams from Startup Weekend: Mind Palace (1st Place),
 Outspoken (2nd Place), Tong For Change (3rd Place), Mucho (Most
 Creative), Hear to Learn (Most Impactful), besides receiving attractive
 prizes will also get green-lane to *SCAPE HubQuarters Fellowship
 programme, which grants them an exemption from the screening
 interview and selection by *SCAPE and programme partner, Reactor
 Ventures.



HubQuarters Fellowship Programme

- HubQuarters Fellowship is a 6 months accelerator programme in partnership with Reactor Ventures that will be launched in October 2018. 30 teams will be selected through our profiling platform to identify their readiness and needs, leading to the provision of support that they require. Participants will then be trained on the necessary skillsets and be empowered with the right tools and frameworks to kick-start their entrepreneurship journey.
- The programme consist of 11- weeks of modular trainings (surrounding topics such as Lean Methodology, Customer Discovery and Problem Identification etc.) and 11-weeks of one-to-one mentorship from industry veterans
- On demo day, entrepreneurs will showcase their ideas to a panel comprising of entrepreneurs, venture capitals and personals from National Youth Council (NYC) and raiSE. At the end of the panel, participants will have the opportunity to receive investor funding as well as grants from DBS, Young ChangeMakers (NYC) and VentureForGood (raiSE)

 - Discounts / Coupons for Tools & Software for Co-Founders
